On November 3, 4 and 5, 2023 the Worcester AGO will be holding a festival to honor of the 150th anniversary of the birth of German composer, Max Reger (1873-1916). Schoenberg, his contemporary, was quoted as saying that Reger represented 'a new technique' of change looking forward. In his brief 46 years, Reger expanded the compositional language for the organ, leaving a profound portfolio of works accessible to a wide range of performers.
